Is the hotel located close to the airport?

The Hampton Inn & Suites – Amelia Island, also known as the Harbor Front Hampton Inn and Suites, is located about 28 miles from Jacksonville International Airport, a 30-40 minute drive. The attached map shows the hotel in relation to the airport. There are several shuttle services as well as taxi service to and from the airport and the hotel. Where are the courses held?

The courses are held at the hotel. Breakfast is provided by the hotel to all the guests. Our caterer, Karen Miller, of “Old South Yankee” prepares scrumptious lunches for all our course attendees every day. Evening receptions are held in the second floor dining room.

If I drive to the hotel is there any cost for parking? What are the directions to the hotel?

If I want to shop or dine what are my local options?

On the hotel's website you will find a list of local restaurants, but merely step outside the hotel and within a five minute walk you will find over fifteen different eateries to sample and also have a number of different shops and boutiques to shop to your heart's content. The hotel is a short walk from a small port which houses local sightseeing, fishing and a ferry to St. Mary's, GA. There are festivals and several events held throughout the year, and The Garden Show will be held March 3-4, 2012 <http://ameliagarden.com/>

What entertainment is available?

There are several nightclubs and a pub or two that feature entertainment on some of the weekend nights. Live entertainment at restaurants is a daily occurrence at Amelia Island. In addition there are various recreational options including golf, tennis and miniature golf within a short driving distance.

Besides the courses, are there any social events or tours scheduled?

There are no optional tours scheduled in conjunction with the Camp as of this writing, although a reception is planned for the attendees and this will be outlined in your attendee e-mail update.

Can I register for any additional courses after my initial registration, or on-site?

You can register for additional courses by completing an additional registration form and paying the applicable course fee. If space is available, you will be confirmed in the course.

For those already registered who wish to add another course on-site, we will be able to handle this for you. You may only use a check or credit card for this purpose.

Are any meals included in the Camp?

Your confirmation advises you that the Hampton Inn offers a breakfast to all registered guests, while breaks and lunch is provided for you each day that you are registered to attend courses.

Can I stay at another hotel other than the Hotel where the Camp is located?

We recommend that you stay at the Hampton Inn as it offers easy access to the courses and local attractions, offers a complimentary breakfast, and offers a great rate for the Camp dates. However if you wish to stay at another location you may, but we cannot offer you any transportation options and you will be responsible for your own breakfast.

Should I rent a car?

This is an option, not a necessity, as there are a number of attractions within walking distance of the hotel; it is more cost effective to take a shuttle to and from the airport. See above for shuttle information that is available as of October 2011, and the attached map provide you with driving directions and general area information.

Can I stay at the Hotel at the same rate before and after the Camp dates?

The hotel rate is effective the day before and after the scheduled Camp dates. You can check with the hotel to extend the rate before and after this range, but we cannot guarantee the rate.

Where and when is the next Camp? Are the same courses being offered? What are the dates, hotel information and costs?

The next Camp is scheduled at Amelia Island July 26-31, 2012. The schedule of courses will be posted on the website by the end of January, but there is no guarantee they will be offered as

the course selection is based on seasonal requests. The schedule and registration information will be posted on the website by January 27th, 2012. An outline and additional information will be available on the website, www.dhmethod.com, and Hotel information and other preliminary cost data will be posted there.

Will new courses be offered in the next Camps? What is the schedule of select courses?

The comments in the evaluations after each Camp and other input is taken into account as we plan future Camps. In accordance with the trends we have experienced the last few years, as well as changes and updates in educational requirements, technological changes, ADA updates on accreditation and needs of educators and practitioners, and we update, modify, add or delete certain courses. All courses we have developed are not offered at every Camp due to various factors, so we suggest you check the website for specific Camp dates, locations and course schedules.

Will we receive a certificate for each course attended?
